Using Technology to Transform Ukulele Methodology

- This approach is based on personal experience
 - I tried to teach ukulele as a traditional instrument (e.g. method book) and this approach was failing, even with initial student buy in.
 - Students want to emulate what they see on YouTube
 - Dr. Jill Reese began making play along videos in 2015
 - I resisted using these videos, but gave in. The videos were a hit!
 - I started making my own videos: over 600 at this point!
 - Copyright is taken care of by YouTube
 - I realized the work could go further
 - I studied the chord frequency used in the play along videos
 - I organized the songs in order of the frequency of chords into a method
